To use H5P, you need access to a computer or mobile device with Internet connection, a browser, a CMS, the H5P plugin or integration and media files.

Investment required

H5P itself is a free and open-source software tool.

It can be used for interactive content creation for websites by combining different elements such as texts, images, video clips, music, and animations.

Possible restriction

It is designed for specific CMS platforms like Moodle, WordPress, and Drupal.
