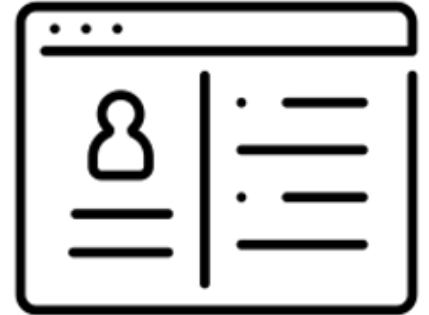
The tool

Description

Material required

A device with an internet connection.

Investment required

Adobe Portfolio is included for free with a Creative Cloud subscription. WordPress offers free hosting and support. Cargo Collective charges €14 per month.

Possible uses

To create your portfolio using templates for the design or building of your own web.

Possible restriction

Need a paid plan to access advanced features.

Setting up a website – hosting, themes, photos, video galleries, etc. - has a significant impact on the carbon footprint. These tools might consume a lot of energy depending on their performance and usability. It is fundamental to incorporate Green Digital Practice (see factsheet and module on the MOOC in this respect) to create climate-friendly portfolios (by using green hosting, sustainable code, and themes, not overloading the webpage, etc.)

Is it inclusive?

All three portfolio alternative tools offer accessibility options, such as the ability to increase the font size, add Alt Text to images, add plugins such as WP accessibility or use accessibility-ready themes.
