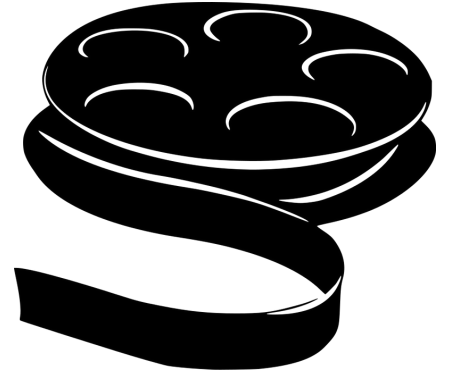


STOCK FOOTAGE AND AUDIO

Stock footage and audio websites provide video and audioclips that can be obtained either for free or with a paid license. They can be royalty-free or require crediting the authors.

Material required

To use them it, you only need access to a computer with an internet connection.

Investment required

It depends on the websites, paid licences can range from: 30 to 150 € per month.

Possible uses

Stock footage websites provide video sequences that you can use in your edits to illustrate a point or simply to practice and create a showreel!

Possible restriction

You should obtain a license from the stock footage provider and follow their attribution guidelines.

Avoid using footage that depicts people or places that require consent.
